

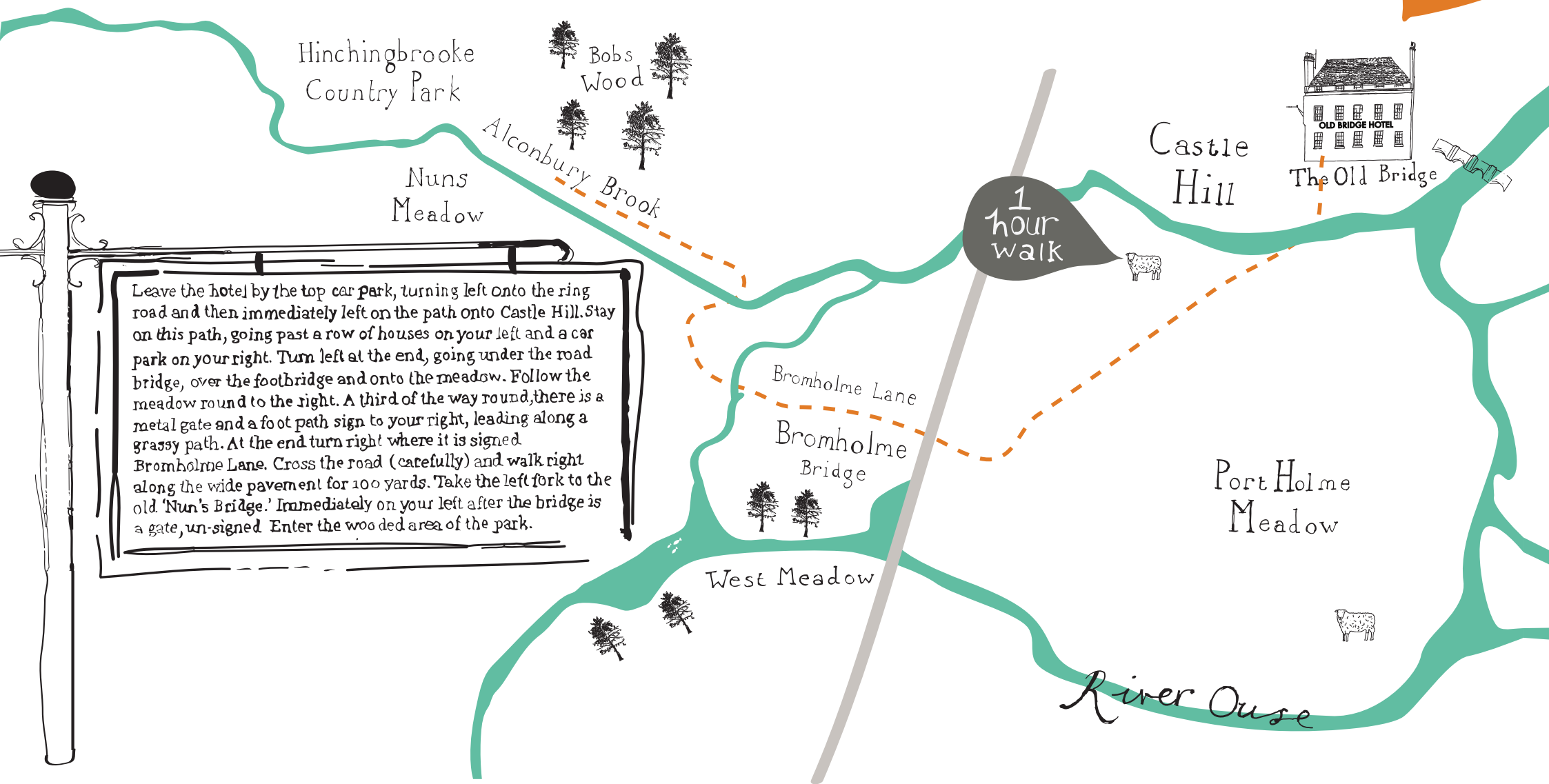


The Old Bridge to Hinchingsbrooke Country Park



A peaceful and beautiful area; mixing woodland, lakes an education centre and even a 'Lama experience.'
Drive there in five minutes (take first exit from ring road towards A1 south, then signs to Hinchinbrooke.)
and just wander around. Or enjoy an hour's walk (30 minutes jog) plus however long you spend in the park.
If meadow is flooded you will have to take the car!

Start walk here



Leave the hotel by the top car park, turning left onto the ring road and then immediately left on the path onto Castle Hill. Stay on this path, going past a row of houses on your left and a car park on your right. Turn left at the end, going under the road bridge, over the footbridge and onto the meadow. Follow the meadow round to the right. A third of the way round, there is a metal gate and a foot path sign to your right, leading along a grassy path. At the end turn right where it is signed Bromholme Lane. Cross the road (carefully) and walk right along the wide pavement for 100 yards. Take the left fork to the old 'Nun's Bridge.' Immediately on your left after the bridge is a gate, un-signed. Enter the wooded area of the park.
