The Old Bridge to Port Holme Meadow

Stomp around England's biggest water meadow. (225 acers.) Despite the unpromising start (under A14) this is a nature-lover's paradise. An hour walk or a 30 minute jog. Flooded (obviously) for much of the winter.

Leave the hotel by the top car park, turning left onto the ring road and then immediately left on the path onto Castle Hill. Stay on this path, going past a row of houses on your left and a car park on your right. Turn left at the end, going under the road bridge, over the footbridge and onto the meadow. Follow the meadow as you choose, diverting into pretty Godmanchester if you have the time and inclination.
